
SEVENTH EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE BOARD MEETING

DOLE and DMW Roles & Responsibilities, One Repat Center

A joint circular was signed between DOLE Secretary Bienvenido Laguesma and DMW Secretary Susan Ople on 14 July 2022 during a press conference held in Quezon City defining the roles between the two departments.

The said circular defines the powers and responsibilities of the DMW Secretary under RA 11641, the law that created DMW.

As stipulated under Section 5 of the said act, all the functions, powers, and mandates of POEA will be absorbed by DMW and the following entities:

All Philippine Overseas Labor Offices (POLO) under DOLE;
The International Labor Affairs Bureau (ILAB) under DOLE;
The National Reintegration Center for OFWs (NRICO) under OIWA;
The National Maritime Polytechnic (NMP) under the DOLE; and
The Office of the Social Welfare Attache (OSWA) under the DSWD.
The Office of the Undersecretary for Migrant Workers Affairs (OUMWA) of the DFA will likewise be under the DMW.
The DMW Secretary shall have administrative control and supervision over the above-listed

entities. However, DOLE and POEA temporarily shall retain authority over quasi-judicial functions and issuance of licenses to recruitment and staffing agencies. All officials and employees of the affected offices and agencies will continue to function and perform their duties on a holdover capacity. The joint circular authorizes both secretaries to reassign personnel

to ensure the continued delivery of services to the public. On 20 July 2022, the Department of Migrant Workers launched its One Repatriation Center (One Repat-DMW) to address immediate repatriation, welfare, and other concerns of distressed OFWs. This new center will ensure that distressed OFWs will be given the needed repatriation assistance and come to be with their families and loved ones.

Immediate families or next of kin or even the distressed OFWs can reach DMW on hotline number 1-348 where a team of case and welfare officers, and medical professionals will be available on a 24/7 basis.

The center is located on the second floor of the Blas F. Ople Building (POEA) EDSA corner Ortigas Avenue and equipped with computers and phones with NDD/IDD capability to connect DMW offices local and abroad and it also maintains a satellite office at the OIWA office in Pasay City.

Advance BOD Election



Last 30 September 2022, PICE Qatar held its annual General Assembly and Elections of Officers. The timing is almost two months ahead of the scheduled General Assembly and Election of Officers as mandated by the Constitution and By Laws currently in effect.
